Policy Americans With Disabilities (ADA)	
Date Initiated: 04/05/10	

Purpose: To ensure the safety and well-being of our passengers by affirming Cherokee County Transit's commitment to providing equal opportunity for persons with disabilities.

Policy Statement: Service will be provided without discrimination against any person including any person with a disability. Discrimination on the basis of disability against any person by Cherokee Transit employees will not be condoned and will not be tolerated.

Guidelines:

- 1. Cherokee County Transit will comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA) and the Rehabilitation Act of 1993.
- 2. Cherokee County Transit will train personnel to properly assist and treat individuals with disabilities with sensitivity.
- 3. Cherokee County Transit will train drivers to operate vehicles and equipment safely including how to use the accessibility equipment and accommodate the different types of common wheelchairs.

Consequences:

- 1. All complaints of discrimination on the basis of disability will be promptly and objectively investigated and forwarded to the Transit Director of Cherokee County.
- 2. Corrective or disciplinary action will be taken for behavior prohibited by this policy, up to and including termination of employment.

Management Responsibilities:

Cherokee County Transit management is responsible for ensuring personnel are trained to proficiency in transporting passengers, including those with disabilities.
