

ORDINANCE OF REPEAL OF OBSOLETE, SUPPLANTED & SUPERSEDED ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, Cherokee County, a body politic and subdivision of the State of North Carolina, is empowered under the North Carolina General Statutes to enact local ordinances applying to the governance of Cherokee County.

WHEREAS, over time, ordinances may become obsolete or are supplanted or superseded by state or federal law.

WHEREAS, it is necessary and proper as the managers of good governance to purge such obsolete, supplanted, or superseded ordinances from the canon of law.

WHEREFORE, it is hereby DECLARED and ORDAINED by the Cherokee County Board of Commissioners that the following ordinances adopted by the Cherokee County Board of Commissioners are hereby repealed and declared null and void as of the date of adoption of this ordinance of repeal:


