


**Cherokee County Commissioner
Electoral Districts
May 2012**



In May 2012, the citizens of Cherokee County voted in favor of increasing the number of electoral districts from three (3) to five (5). The election cycle will now be as follows: during the 2014 election cycle, there shall be an election to elect the three (3) expiring seats for Districts One (1), Three (3), and Four (4); then during the 2016 general election cycle, there shall be an election to replace the two (2) "At-Large" seats with the Districts Two (2) and Five (5) seats. All of these terms shall continue to be four (4) year staggered terms. Additionally, all five seats shall continue to be elected county-wide and all candidates shall reside in the District for which they are seeking election.
